## **Worksheet Round Instructions and Sample**

The worksheet round is team-based in which the entire team confers and writes its responses on a single 20-question worksheet. Both team receive the same worksheet.

At the beginning of the worksheet round, the moderator places one copy of the worksheet face down in front of each team. The moderator does not announce the topic/theme of the worksheet. Teams are given two (2) minutes to write answers to the questions. A team writes its name on the back of the worksheet, and when start time is called, turns the worksheet over and begins to work. Team members may confer, and one or more team members may write responses in the allotted spaces. Team members may also move from their chairs to have the best view of the worksheet.

At the end of the two-minute period, the moderator collects the worksheets and scores them, announcing correct responses and indicating which team got correct answers. Because both teams had the same worksheet, there is no rebounding.

Correct responses are valued at 10 points each. Worksheet topics are wide and varied, but they are most often alphabetically oriented (all answers begin with AE.@ for example) or thematically related (people and events of the 1960s, for example).
